1.4 Event Location

1.4.1 Virtual Platform

CPAC's Virtual Qualifier will be hosted as a live event through our website at live.cpac.events. All submitted videos will be combined and broadcast at the designated showtime. The event streaming platform will be available two weeks prior to the virtual event.

1.5 Tickets

Your competitor registration includes access to the event. A unique competitor ticket access code will be provided via email following the Video Submission Deadline.

Ticket holders can watch the broadcast live and on-demand for 24 hours after the show.

1.6 Pre-Competition Checklist
